

Bear Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District
Minutes
Commissioners Meeting
June 29, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Church at 9:30AM.

- Commissioners Present: Church, Austin, Klein, Jalinski, Jensen
- Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve the minutes of the April 13, 2019 Commissioners meeting was made by Rob Jensen and seconded by Tom Church. Motion passed.
- Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's Report was presented by Mic Austin. The savings account balance is \$39,265.32. The checking account balance is \$6,362.36. The dam trust account balance is \$6,431.88. The August tax levy is \$1,347.56. Motion to accept the Treasurer's report was made by Rick Klein and seconded by Mic Austin. Motion passed.
- Landing Inspector's Appointment: Mic Austin said he would not be able to continue doing the landing inspections next year. There was discussion concerning how difficult it would be to find someone else to do that job. Chairman Church said without a person to do the boat inspections he was reluctant to apply for the state grant.
- Snakes in the Lake: Mic reported that Allysa Hoekstra from the Rhinelander DNR office would be coming to the annual meeting to discuss snakes. Chairman Church expressed interest in getting some questions ahead of time to have a more informed discussion.
- Fish Stocking: The cost to stock the species of fish from the DNR is \$2 each. Last year we stocked 2,000 fish.
- Lake Management Plan: Mic Austin has called the DNR again, but we have not been given final approval of our plan.
- Clean Boats Clean Water: We started inspecting boats the Monday before Memorial Day and as of June 23rd we have inspected 79 boats with 149 hours of inspection. Fully 55% of the boats had been on other lakes within the last five days.
- Annual Lake Inspection: The second year of inspection was completed June 23rd. All the samples are in the lab. We are waiting for results. There was no sign of rusty crawfish. We did find yellow iris on the lake.
- Updated Mailing List: Chairman Church reported he purchased the updated list from the county.
