

Greetings Bear Lake Property Owners;

As some of you are aware, a group of beavers has begun to build dams near the spillway on Bear Creek. These dams have the potential of negatively affecting the water level on the lake. At the June meeting of the Bear Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District, the board voted to have the beavers removed. Subsequently, a professional trapper has been hired to undertake the task. Traps will be placed just under the surface of the water in the creek, in an area surrounded by private property, on Tuesday, June 27<sup>th</sup>. The hope is that the beavers can be removed in just a few days. As this process takes place, please, please, please do not venture into this area of the creek. One reason is if you are on the land in this area, you would be trespassing. Another, and even more important reason, is that these traps are dangerous. They can cause serious injury to a human and kill other animals, (like dogs), if triggered. So please stay away so that this process can be completed quickly and safely. Another communication will go out once the coast is clear. Thanks for your cooperation.
